National Scholarships and Grants to Which You Can Apply

LACF welcomes applications or nominations recognizing underrepresented groups, including women, First Nations, Inuit, and Métis peoples, people of colour, people who identify as LGBTQ, and people with disabilities.

Research Grants

Deadline: October 15, 2025

For BLA and MLA Students

Eligibility: students completing a major project or thesis work consistent with the LACF mandate.

Award: Two awards up to \$2,500

For Ph.D. Students, Practitioners, Educators

Eligibility: PhD students, practitioners, educators, and others exploring questions relevant to the profession or practice of landscape

architecture.

Award: Up to \$10,000

Frederick Gage Todd National Scholarship

Eligibility: Final year students in CSLA-accredited MLA programs.

Award: \$15,000

Application deadline: May 7, 2026

Peter Jacobs Indigenous Scholarship

Eligibility: Canadian Indigenous students enrolled in CSLA accredited programs.

Award: \$6,000

Application deadline: November 1, 2025

BC2 Indigenous Scholarship

Eligibility: Canadian Indigenous students with an interest in landscape architecture enrolled in their last year of an undergraduate programs in disciplines related to landscape architecture (such as architecture, planning, geography, environmental sciences, horticulture, fine art, natural sciences, etc.)

Award: \$4,000

Application deadline: November 1, 2025

Regional Scholarships to Which You Can Apply

Peter Klynstra Memorial Scholarship

Eligibility: Students of CSLA accredited programs intending to practice in Atlantic Canada.

Award: \$4,000

Application deadline: September 30, 2025

Atlantic Landscape/Dalhousie Scholarship

Eligibility: Students of Dalhousie BTLA program intending to practice in Atlantic Canada.

Award: \$4,000

Application deadline: September 30, 2025

SALA Academic Award

Eligibility: Residents of Saskatchewan studying in accredited programs outside the province (world-wide).

Award: \$3,000

Application deadline: September 30, 2025

Andre Schwabenbauer Scholarship NAIT

Eligibility: Graduates of NAIT enrolled in CSLA or ASLA accredited program.

Award: \$1,500

Application deadline: September 30, 2025
